ASBESTOS DEPARTMENT:

Commencing January 11, 2010, all pre-trial motions in asbestos cases and other matters as designated by the Presiding Judge shall be noticed and heard in a department or departments to be designated from time to time by the Presiding Judge and referred to herein as the Asbestos Department or Departments. All asbestos pre-trial motions must be calendared through the Clerk's Office by calling (415) 551-3688 between the hours of 9:00 am and 12:00 pm, Monday through Friday.

Motions affecting the trial date are exempted from this order and shall continue to be heard in Department 206, until further notice.

CASE MANAGEMENT:

When a complaint is filed, the clerk will designate on its face a case management conference date no later than 180 days from the filing. Prior to the case management conference, the Court will review the file to verify compliance with California Rules of Court, Rule 3.110. Failure to comply


1 with the requirements set forth therein, including service, responsive pleading and default, may result
2 in the cancellation of the case management conference and the issuance of an order to show cause.


